Atlanta IS	Naviance	11 and 12	School pays – no extra fee	
IS Lausanne	Moresby	10 and 11	Optional, so paid for by students who choose it: cCHF370	We offer the Morrisby Test, administered by Guy Sutton at Babcock International (formerly Indigo & International Guidance Services). We used to offer the Euroquest Test, administered by Alan Beckett at Step One, but found that this was evolving to be less a battery of psychometric tests and more an interest-based assessment.  We offer it to students in Years 11 and 12 (Grades 10 and 11) in October/November. Most of our students opt to take it in Year 11.

Yokohama IS	Naviance	11 and 12 (intending to extend to 9 and 10 soon)	School pays – no extra fee	
Chinese IS, Hong Kong	Naviance, Interquest	9-12 (Naviance) 10 (Interquest)	School pays for both – no extra fee	We use both Naviance and Interquest (international school version of Euroquest). Naviance is introduced to our students in Year 10, which they use through the university application process in Year 13. Years 10 and 11 with Naviance is largely centered on career exploration, which gradually switches over to the application process in Years 12 and 13. Interquest is administered to all students in fall of Year 11 so that results are back in time for them be factored into consideration of IB Diploma Program course selection.
American School of Bombay	Naviance	Years 11 and 12	School pays – no extra fee	We use Naviance but only for our college counseling office (so not nearly to all of its capacity). This is primarily used by years 11 and 12 though we are moving this down into year 10 slowly.
IS Kuala Lumpur	Naviance	9-12	School pays – no extra fee	Next year we will be introducing Naviance to all high school students. Currently the juniors and seniors use it for their college search/applications and filling out surveys that we create. Next year we will be rolling it out to sophomores with the career exploration piece. There is also a resume builder that we will be using with the rising seniors.

British School, New Delhi	Naviance	11 and 12	School pays – no extra fee	We use Naviance and have done so for three years: it works well for us.

ICS Zurich	Euroquest	10s	School pays – no extra fee	We've used Euroquest for a few years now but are considering switching to Naviance.
American School Foundation of Monterrey	Naviance	9-12	School pays – no extra fee	We use Naviance. Our College Counselor cannot live without it.
IS Beijing	Naviance	9-12	School pays – no extra fee	In our High School we use Naviance for the last three or four years. While we had mostly used it for the grades 11 and 12 for college and career planning, we now use it with grades 9 and 10. Our Counseling department also pushes it with our parents as a source of information. The SAT/GPA section reflecting our own students historically is very useful for a ballpark indication of which colleges may be a good match for an individual. Sending the majority of college applications off is now facilitated by using the electronic section. [We have about 150 grade 12 and 160 grade 11 students with two college counselors dealing with all their needs.

IS Belgrade	Naviance	All HS grades	School pays – no extra fee	I have the Naviance package for Careers and Learning Styles (just got it this year) and it's fabulous. If your school already uses Naviance I think it's only a few hundred dollars extra to add this on and open it up to your entire student body. I've used it with all of the grades already (we hosted a Career Day about a month ago and introducing the kids to these tools and letting them fill out the surveys was one of the prep things we did). It worked great and the kids loved. It's ongoing so they can use it repeatedly, and what's nice about Naviance is that you can link careers to majors (or rather, it does it for you) and then to universities where these majors are on offer.
