However, we ask for a lot of documentation as part of our application package so we can normally decide whether or not we can accept an applicant on the basis of that. When we have any questions concerning placement (such as Southern Hemisphere or Korean transfers) where the academic year is not in sync with ours, we have started doing the shortened MAP tests (we test our students in Grades 2-10 anyway) to gauge levels and finalise placement.

We have occasionally used the OPI from ACER for remote online assessments, for math and English. We use MAP along with other in-house assessments when there is a question about grade placement, but that can only be done on site. For students with possible EAL needs, we use the WIDA and/or WAPT (also on site).	Either
