You provide all teachers with a school owned laptop for the full duration of their contract:	39/ 79	49%	
You provide all teachers with a school owned laptop only for the first year of their contract. Then they need to make their own arrangements as/ if needed:	2/ 79	2,5%	
You subsidise your teachers with a set amount at the beginning of their contract to buy a new computer, as/ if needed:	8/ 79	10%	Subsidy from 500 to 1000 USD.
Teachers that have either been provided with a school owned computer or have been subsidised to buy a new one, can opt for “buying” that computer from the school upon completion of the term of use, at a special price:	6/ 79	8%	
You expect and as such inform all newly hired teachers that they need to have their own laptop and provide them with the minimum technical specifications:	4/ 79	5%	
You have desktops in each classroom and as such teachers are not required to have their own computer while at school:	18/ 79	23%
