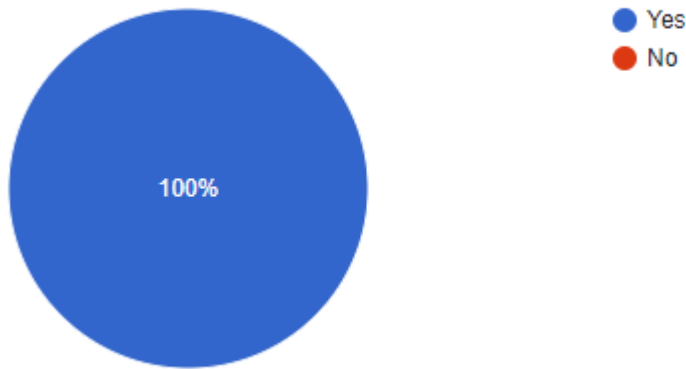


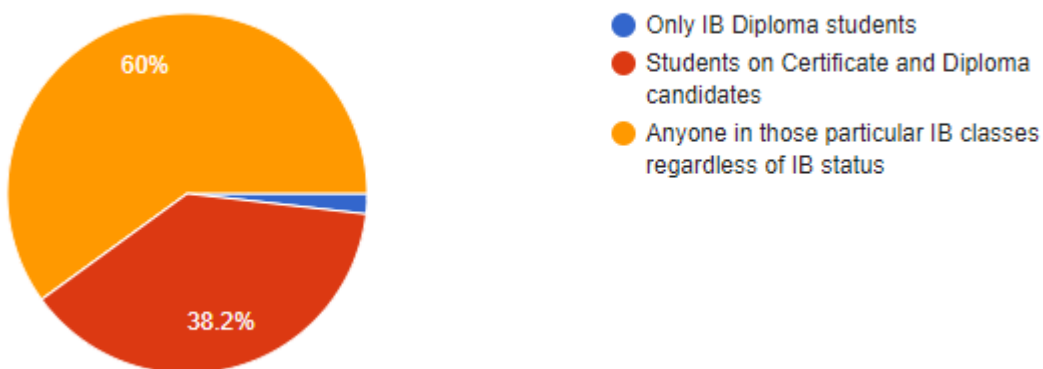

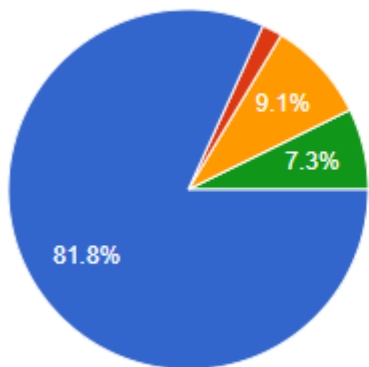
Do you offer Mock Exams to IB Students?



Which students sit the Mocks?

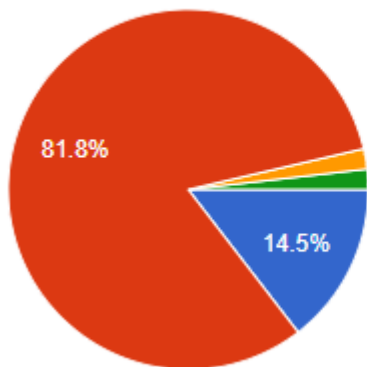


How are Mocks offered?



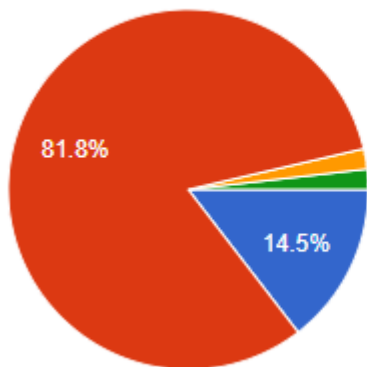
- Separate testing window, outside of class time

When are Mocks offered?



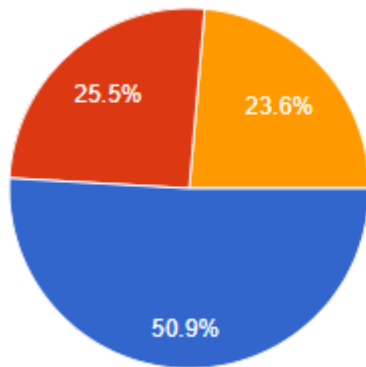
- End of 1st Semester

When are Mocks offered?



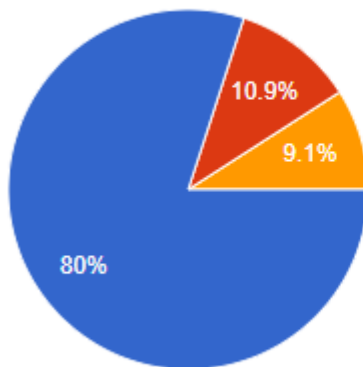
- End of 1st Semester

Who invigilates the Mocks?



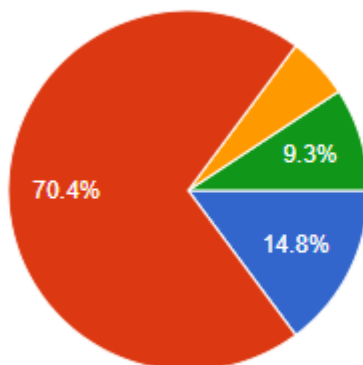
- IB Coordinator and team
