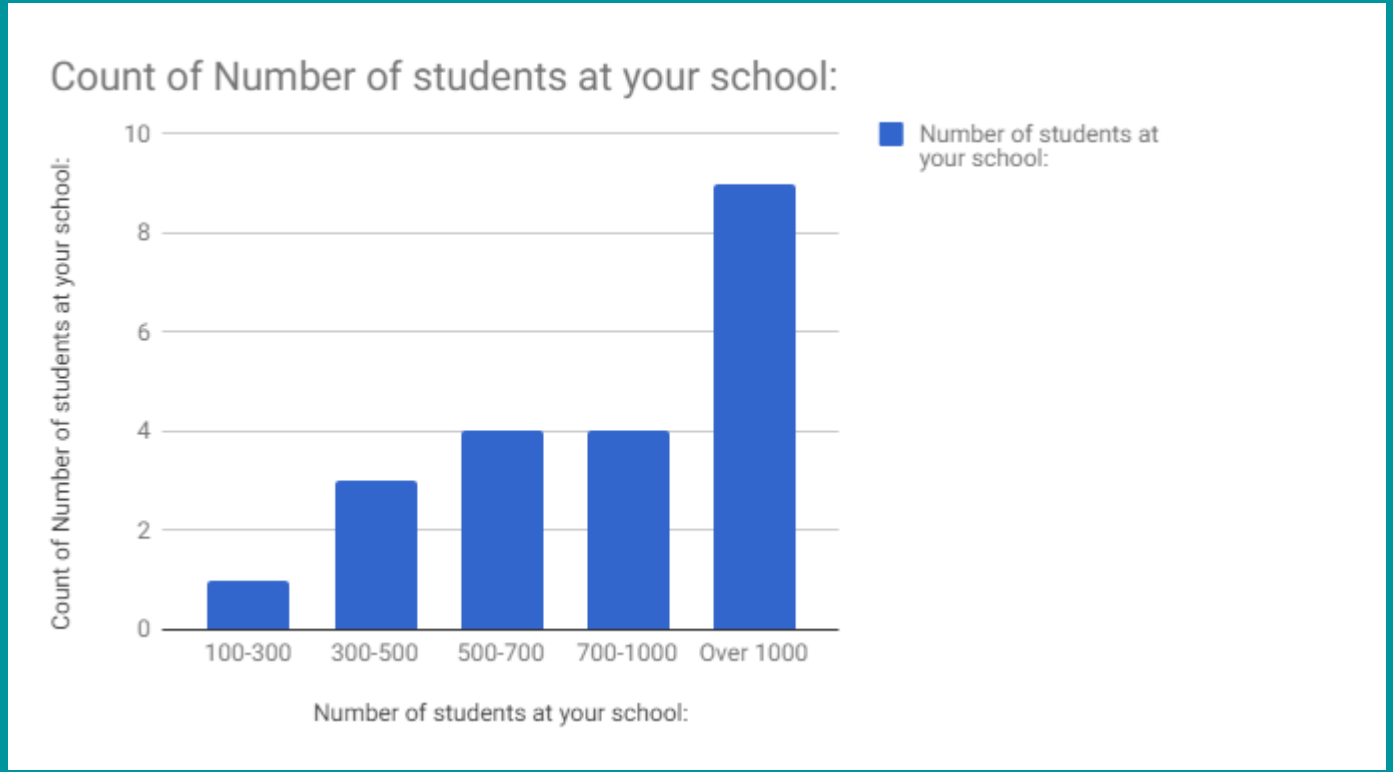

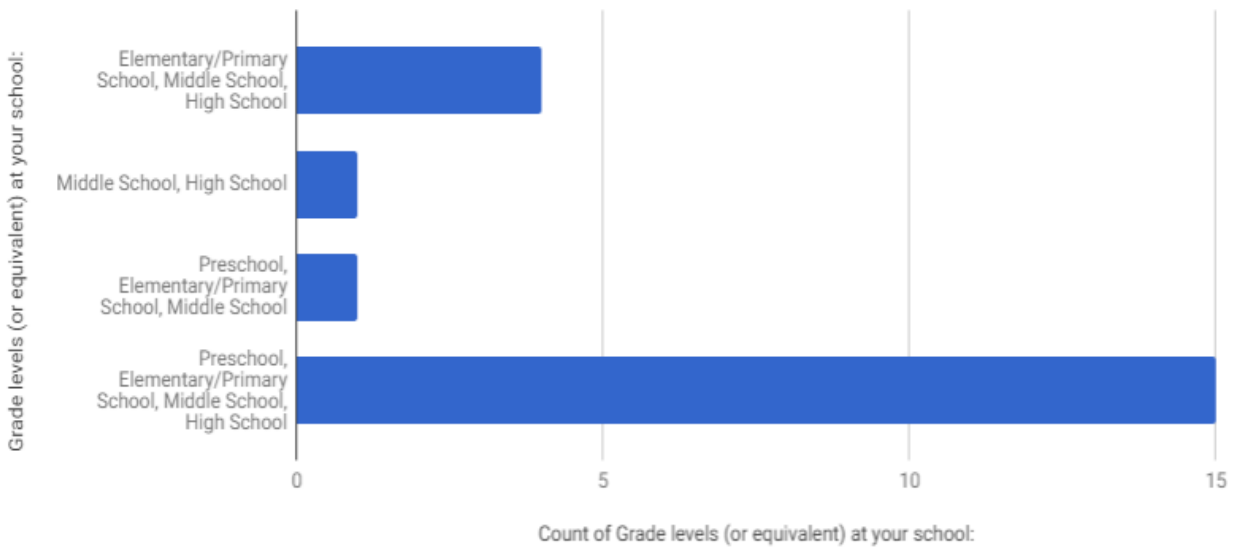

### What is the number of students at your school?



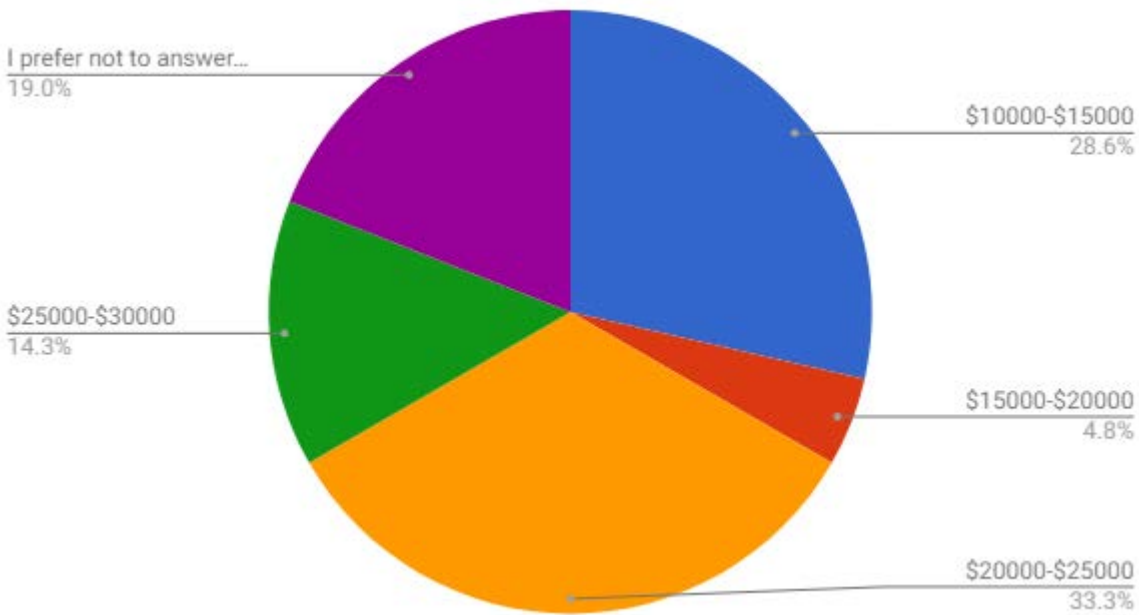
## What grade levels make up your school?

Count of Grade levels (or equivalent) at your school:

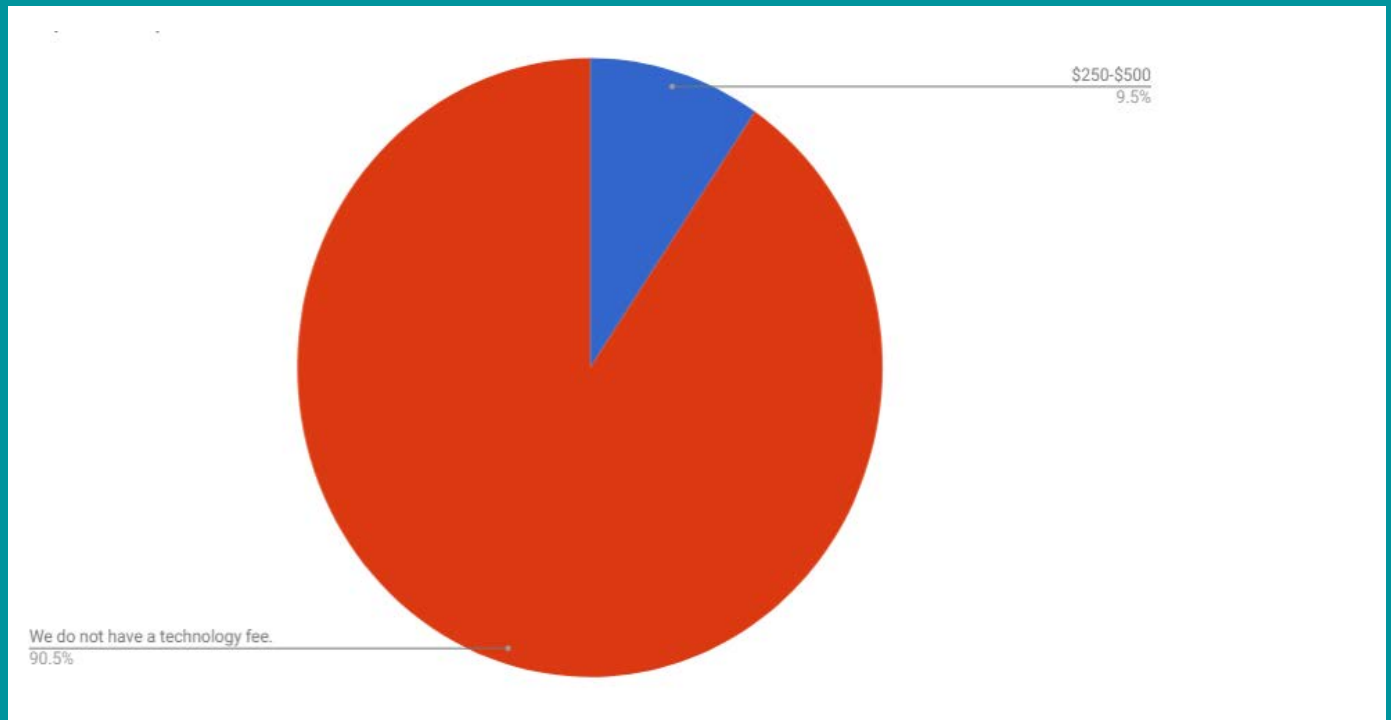


## What is the yearly cost of tuition?
