



Other responses:

- Pmp/PE and music- yes, Chinese no.
- Yes, but within the same building.
- PE and library take place in the gym and library respectively.
- At times... it depends on the planning and intention. We have recognized that as we work interdisciplinary there are times where specialists will teach a balance of knowledge, skill and understanding... there needs to be skill and sometimes pull out lessons meet this need. We recognize that we need flexibility and that our schedule needs to be adaptable so we employ as few specialists as possible who will work beyond KG so that we can take an 'atelierista' approach without timetable constraints from elementary school.
- Only for PE
- "In the classroom mainly, but also for Outdoor learning and forest, which are big parts of our approach"
- In PK the teacher comes to them as much as possible expect PE and library, K visit the specialists in their learning environments except ELL.
- Some, but not all.
- PE, Library.
- Pre K have music and Russian teachers come to them. They go to the library and gym.
- Preschool music and art studios are in the EY building along with kindergarten art. All Kindergarten music are in main music classrooms.
- Only when they need to!
- Pre-K they join the children in the learning Centers 5-6 year old's go to the specialists classrooms.
- Only Swimming
- Depending on the structured play.
- Art- no, PE- yes, Swimming- no.
